Rules and Regulations

All persons competing or attending any the showcase series or Eastern Miniatures show are subject to the following rules which must be obeyed at all times by all persons attending the show

- 1. Once an entry has been made, no fees will be refunded without a vet/doctors certificate.
- 2. The judge's decision is final. Any objections must be made in writing to the show secretary within 30mins of the incident and be accompanied by a deposit of £10.00 refundable only if the objection is upheld.
- 3. AT ALL TIMES when mounted, riders MUST wear correctly fastened protective headgear to BS EN 1384, PAS015 or ASTM F1163 standards.
- 4. The organizers reserve the right to refuse entry to any class or the show-ground
- 5. All dogs must be kept on leads.
- 6. Children's age is to be taken on the date of the show.
- 7. No person shall allow a stallion for which he/she is responsible, to compete or be prepared to compete, in any competitions without taking adequate precautions to ensure that other members of the public are not put at risk of injury.
- 8. Stallions and Colts may be led by a child as long as the child is competent, if the judge considers the child not in control they may ask for the exhibit leave the ring
- 9. Please do not muck out your lorry/trailer onto the fields.
- 10. Please take your litter home with you or use the bins provided.
- 11. Smoking is only permitted in designated areas, and prohibited around the stables.
- 12. All bookings of the centre, once confirmed, are liable to a 50% cancellation fee should they be moved or cancelled.
- 13. The showcase Series an reserve the right to cancel, add or amend any of the competitions as they see fit, due to weather conditions etc.
- 14. Children must be under adult supervision at all times.
- 15. All horses/ponies must only move through areas shared with pedestrians at walk.
- 16. No Venue, nor any of its representative or staff shall be held liable for any accident, injury, damage or loss what-so-ever.
- 17. Any animal showing signs of disease or illness will be asked to leave the show ground immediately
- 18. Please conduct yourself in a courteous manner, any abuse to person or animal will not be tolerated and will be asked to leave the show-ground.
- 19. ANY person whether spectator or competitor, that has been banned from any other affiliated show within the last 2 years will
- 20. Competitors are advised to have public liability insurance
- 21. Any complaints must be taken up with the secretaries with a deposit of £40 within 20 minutes of the incident.
- 22. This show will be run with a social media code of conduct. Any cyber bullying, coercion of judges or show team members will not be tolerated in any way. Slanderous or libel comments put on social media will be taking seriously and action taken.
- 23. NO lunging in collecting rings.

Qualifiers

EASA- The East Anglian Showing Awards is new for 2024. We have joined forces with other clubs in East Anglia to unite our clubs on things like rules and class specification, but most importantly we are encouraging local showing. The ability to gain points across the participating clubs in over 20 commonly offered classes. This will result in a black tie awards evening in November 2024, with wonderful prizes and awards. This show is a qualifier for The Sunshine Tour Championships held at The All-England Showground, Hickstead from Thursday 12. – Sunday 15. September 2024. The Championships are for unaffiliated and amateur competitors in Dressage from Intro to Elementary, Show Jumping from Lead Rein to 1.0m; Showing for lead rein, in-hand, ridden, working hunter, veterans, plus many more, Eventer's Challenge from 50cm through to 90cm.

Qualification: Dressage & Show Jumping $1_{-} - 3_{-}$ place; Showing & Eventers Challenge $1_{-} - 4_{-}$ place. Qualification does not pass down the line.

Registration of qualification must be completed within 1 month of competition (sooner for late July shows). Restrictions apply to both horse and competitor's previous winnings and amateur status, please check the website for Terms & Conditions.

Ring 1- Outdoor School

Class 1: Youngstock- open to any breed or type, yearlings, two and three year olds

Class 2: Novice Horse or Pony- open to any breed or type, not to have won three or more 1sts in the past 18months, please use this class in the way it should be, any age

Class 3: Open Stallion or Gelding- open to any breed or type, horses to be 4years and older

Class 4: Open Mare- open to any breed or type, horses to be 4years and older

- Class 5: Young Handler- open to any breed or type, handlers to be under 16 years of age
- Class 6: Senior Handler- open to any breed or type, handlers to be over the age of 16
- **Class 7:** Coloured and Odd Coloured- open to any breed or type, horses to be of broken, spotted, buckskin, palomino, cremello, roan coats, any age
- **Class 8:** Mountain and Moorland- open to any mountain and moorland pony, doesn't have to be registered but should fit the breed standard. Shetland, Welsh A, B, C or D, Dartmoor, Exmoor, New Forest, Connemara, Highland, Fell and Dales, any age
- Class 9: Open Pony- open to any pony not exceeding 14.2hh(148cm), any age
- Class 10: Open Horse- open to any horse exceeding 14.2hh(148cm), any age
- **Class 11:** Foreign and Rare Breed- open Arabs, Warmbloods, Spanish Horses, Exmoors, Suffolk Punch, Clydesdale, Shire etc, any age
- Class 12: Traditional Cobs- open to traditional cobs, any height or age
- Class 13: Veteran- open to horse or pony exceeding 15 years of age

Inhand Championship- 1st and 2nd from classes 1-13

- **Class 14:** Lead Rein and First Ridden- open to any breed or type, snaffle bridles on leadrein ponies, lead rein to be attached to the nose. Lead rein jockeys not to exceed 9 years old, First Ridden jockeys not to exceed 12years old
- **Class 15:** Junior Ridden- open to any breed or type, jockeys not to exceed 16 years of age on the day of the show
- **Class 16:** Ridden Novice- open to any breed or type, not to have won three or more 1sts in the past 18months, please use this class in the way it should be, any age
- **Class 17:** Mountain and Moorland- open to any mountain and moorland pony, doesn't have to be registered but should fit the breed standard. Shetland, Welsh A, B, C or D, Dartmoor, Exmoor, New Forest, Connemara, Highland, Fell and Dales
- Class 18: Open Horse- open to any horse exceeding 14.2hh(148cm)
- Class 19: Open Pony open to any pony not exceeding 14.2hh(148cm)
- Class 20: Veteran- open to horse or pony exceeding 15 years of age
