Rules and Regulations

All persons competing or attending any the showcase series or Eastern Miniatures show are subject to the following rules which must be obeyed at all times by all persons attending the show

1. Once an entry has been made, no fees will be refunded without a vet/doctors certificate.
2. The judge's decision is final. Any objections must be made in writing to the show secretary within 30mins of the incident and be accompanied by a deposit of £10.00 refundable only if the objection is upheld.
3. AT ALL TIMES when mounted, riders MUST wear correctly fastened protective headgear to BS EN 1384, PAS015 or ASTM F1163 standards.
4. The organizers reserve the right to refuse entry to any class or the show-ground
5. All dogs must be kept on leads.
6. Children's age is to be taken on the date of the show.
7. No person shall allow a stallion for which he/she is responsible, to compete or be prepared to compete, in any competitions without taking adequate precautions to ensure that other members of the public are not put at risk of injury.
8. Stallions and Colts may be led by a child as long as the child is competent, if the judge considers the child not in control they may ask for the exhibit leave the ring
9. Please do not muck out your lorry/trailer onto the fields.
10. Please take your litter home with you or use the bins provided.
11. Smoking is only permitted in designated areas, and prohibited around the stables.
12. All bookings of the centre, once confirmed, are liable to a 50% cancellation fee should they be moved or cancelled.
13. The showcase Series an reserve the right to cancel, add or amend any of the competitions as they see fit, due to weather conditions etc.
14. Children must be under adult supervision at all times.
15. All horses/ponies must only move through areas shared with pedestrians at walk.
16. No Venue, nor any of its representative or staff shall be held liable for any accident, injury, damage or loss what-so-ever.
17. Any animal showing signs of disease or illness will be asked to leave the show ground immediately
18. Please conduct yourself in a courteous manner, any abuse to person or animal will not be tolerated and will be asked to leave the show-ground.
19. ANY person whether spectator or competitor, that has been banned from any other affiliated show within the last 2 years will
20. Competitors are advised to have public liability insurance
21. Any complaints must be taken up with the secretaries with a deposit of £40 within 20 minutes of the incident.
22. This show will be run with a social media code of conduct. Any cyber bullying, coercion of judges or show team members will not be tolerated in any way. Slanderous or libel comments put on social media will be taking seriously and action taken.
23. NO lunging in collecting rings.

WORKING HUNTER PONY – MARKS

PHASE 1 - JUMPING – 50 MARKS

PENALTIES – KNOCKDOWN 10 PENALTIES – 1ST REFUSAL 15 PENALTIES – 2ND REFUSAL 20 PENALTIES - 3RD REFUSAL/FALL OF HORSE OR RIDER/TAKING WRONG COURSE/JUMPING ANOTHER FENCE AFTER FINISHING THE COURSE - ELIMINATION.

IF A HORSE/PONY TURNS ITS QUARTERS TO A FENCE, COMPLETELY TURNS AROUND/CIRCLES OR CROSSES ITS TRACKS ON APPROACH TO THE NEXT FENCE, THESE ARE ALL CLASSED AS A REFUSAL.

STYLE OF JUMPING - 20 MARKS

PHASE 2 - MANNERS/INDIVIDUAL SHOW – 10 MARKS - CONFORMATION – 20 MARKS

TOTAL POSSIBLE MARKS 100

PERFORMANCE CLASS

COURSE OF 8 FENCES (NO DOUBLES), WITH A MAX OF 10 MARKS PER FENCE – JUDGED ON THE STYLE OF JUMPING. NO SET PENALTIES FOR A KNOCKDOWN OR REFUSAL, BUT 3 REFUSALS AND /OR FALL OF HORSE/RIDER RESULTS IN ELIMINATION. NO MARK FOR CONFORMATION OR SHOW, BUT A MARK OUT OF 20 WILL BE AWARDED FOR OVERALL IMPRESSION.

TOTAL POSSIBLE MARKS 100

WORKING HUNTER PONY RULES

1. Any suitable bit/bridle allowed – basically use what your pony/horse is used to and goes best in! Any change of tack between phases IS NOT ALLOWED.
2. All types of nose band allowed, as are Standing and Running martingales. DRAW AND SIDEREINS ARE NOT ALLOWED
3. Boots, including overreach boots are allowed in the jumping phase but must be removed for conformation.
4. Whips must not exceed 30ins. Spurs are not allowed in any WHP class. Any misuse of whip will result in elimination.
5. For safety reasons earrings, other than “studs”, are not allowed. The wearing of back protectors is recommended.

Qualifiers

This show is a qualifier for The Sunshine Tour Championships held at The All-England Showground, Hickstead from Thursday 12th – Sunday 15th September 2024. The Championships are for unaffiliated and amateur competitors in **Dressage** from Intro to Elementary, **Show Jumping** from Lead Rein to 1.0m; **Showing** for lead rein, in-hand, ridden, working hunter, veterans, plus many more, **Eventer’s Challenge** from 50cm through to 90cm.

Qualification: Dressage & Show Jumping 1st – 3rd place; Showing & Eventers Challenge 1st – 4th place. Qualification does not pass down the line.

Registration of qualification must be completed within 1 month of competition (sooner for late July shows). Restrictions apply to both horse and competitor’s previous winnings and amateur status, please check the website for Terms & Conditions.

Clear Round- Available from 8.30, course will be set at 40cm. Not judged and no rosettes in this class £5 a go

Class 1: 30cm Lead rein, First Ridden and Novice Working Hunter- open to any one wanting to have a go including young horses/ponies. Lead reins allowed. All fences will be on the bottom hole and set as cross poles or straight bars and not exceed 30cms

Class 2: 40cm Cradle Stakes- open to ponies not exceeding 128cm(12.2hh). Riders 12 years and under. Fences not exceeding 40cm. Lead reins allowed. Ponies to be presented as per their type 

Class 3: 50cm Open Working Hunter - Fence height 50cms. Riders any age. Horses and ponies to be presented as per their type 

Class 4: Mountain and Moorland Working Hunter Pony- Open to M&M ponies of any height or type, fences max 50cm for small breeds and 55cm for large Breeds. Riders of any age 


Class 5: 60cms Performance Class- Open to ponies and Horses. Riders any age. Horses and ponies to be presented as per their type


Working Hunter Morning Championship- 1st and 2nd placings from classes 1-5


Clear Round- Available during the lunch break, course will remain at 60cm. Not judged and no rosettes in this class £5 a go

Lunch Break – 12.30


To recommence 13.15pm


Class 6: 60cm Open Working Hunter- Fence height not to exceed 60cm. Riders any age. Horses and ponies to be presented as per their type 

Class 7: 70cm Open Working Hunter- Fence height not to exceed 70cm. Riders any age. Horses and ponies to be presented as per their type 

Class 8: 80cm Open Working Hunter- Fence height not to exceed 80cm. Riders any age. Horses and ponies to be presented as per their type 

Class 9: 80cms Performance Class- Fence height not to exceed 80cm. Riders any age. Horses and ponies to be presented as per their type

Class 10: Open Working Hunter 90cm- Fence height not to exceed 90cm. Riders any age. Horses and ponies to be presented as per their type 

Class 11: Open Working Hunter 1m- Fence height not to exceed 100cm. Riders any age. Horses and ponies to be presented as per their type
