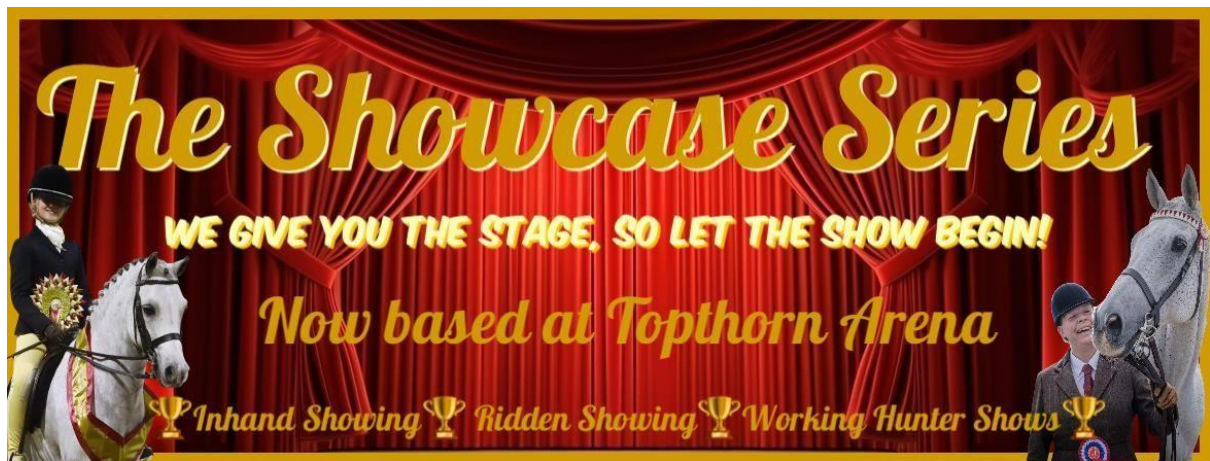

Rules and Regulations

All persons competing or attending any The Showcase Series show are subject to the following rules which must be obeyed at all times by all persons attending the show

1. Once an entry has been made, no fees will be refunded without a vet/doctors certificate.
2. The judge's decision is final. Any objections must be made in writing to the show secretary within 30mins of the incident and be accompanied by a deposit of £10.00 refundable only if the objection is upheld.
3. AT ALL TIMES when mounted, riders MUST wear correctly fastened protective headgear to BS EN 1384, PAS015 or ASTM F1163 standards.
4. The organizers reserve the right to refuse entry to any class or the show-ground
5. All dogs must be kept on leads.
6. Children's age is to be taken on the date of the show.
7. No person shall allow a stallion for which he/she is responsible, to compete or be prepared to compete, in any competitions without taking adequate precautions to ensure that other members of the public are not put at risk of injury.
8. Stallions and Colts may be led by a child as long as the child is competent, if the judge considers the child not in control they may ask for the exhibit leave the ring
9. Please do not muck out your lorry/trailer onto the fields.
10. Please take your litter home with you or use the bins provided.
11. Smoking is only permitted in designated areas, and prohibited around the stables.
12. All bookings of the centre, once confirmed, are liable to a 50% cancellation fee should they be moved or cancelled.
13. The Showcase Series reserve the right to cancel, add or amend any of the competitions as they see fit, due to weather conditions and insufficient entries
14. Children must be under adult supervision at all times.
15. All horses/ponies must only move through areas shared with pedestrians at walk.
16. No Venue, nor any of its representative or staff shall be held liable for any accident, injury, damage or loss what-so-ever.
17. Any animal showing signs of disease or illness will be asked to leave the show ground immediately
18. Please conduct yourself in a courteous manner, any abuse to person or animal will not be tolerated and will be asked to leave the show-ground.
19. ANY person whether spectator or competitor, that has been banned from any other affiliated show within the last 2 years will not be permitted to attend A TSS Show
20. Competitors are advised to have public liability insurance
21. Any complaints must be taken up with the secretaries with a deposit of £40 within 20 minutes of the incident.

22. This show will be run with a social media code of conduct. Any cyber bullying, coercion of judges or show team members will not be tolerated in any way. Slandorous or libel comments put on social media will be taken seriously and action taken.
23. NO lunging in collecting rings.
24. Should a competitor have any link to a judge (or visa versa) in the current or previous year of the show by means of, producing, selling, loan or lease of an animal, showing of an animal (free or for a fee), teaching, sponsorship or brand ambassador, they will not be permitted to judge, or be judged at TSS shows by those persons. A judge may also not judge an animal they have bred. Should this rule found to be broken you will be withdrawn. Judges are permitted to refuse to judge any persons they feel have contravened this ruling.
25. No horses to be tied and left unattended tied to the lorry or trailers
26. All novice class exhibits to be shown in a snaffle or snaffle variation with a single rein.
27. Lead Rein exhibit riders should not exceed 9 years old as of Jan 2024 and ponies should not exceed 128cm. Snaffle bridles only, with the leadrein attached to the noseband.
28. First Ridden exhibit riders should not exceed 12 years old as of Jan 2024 and ponies should not exceed 128cm. Snaffle bridles only.
29. Junior exhibits must not exceed 16 years old as of Jan 2024. Juniors may ride a stallion as long as competent and may use double bridles or double reins, gags and grackle nose bands are permitted for juniors doing working hunter classes.
30. Horses and ponies do not need to be registered to show with us, but may affect qualification to other championships and society qualifiers

Qualifiers

This show is a qualifier for The Sunshine Tour Championships held at The All-England Showground, Hickstead from 17th- 20th September 2026. The Championships are for unaffiliated and amateur competitors in **Dressage** from Intro to Elementary, **Show Jumping** from Lead Rein to 1.0m; **Showing** for lead rein, in-hand, ridden, working hunter, veterans, plus many more, **Eventer's Challenge** from 50cm through to 90cm.

Qualification: Dressage & Show Jumping 1st – 3rd place; Showing & Eventers Challenge 1st – 4th place. Qualification does not pass down the line.

Equine Sports UK Grassroots Championships “This show is affiliated to Equine Sports UK (ESUK) Grassroots Championships taking place at Arena UK, Grantham, Lincolnshire on the 30th July to 1st August 2026. The three highest placed exhibits will qualify in each class”

Concours D'Elegance GB

First, second and third placed horses/ponies not already qualified in eligible classes will qualify for the Champion of Britain Title classes to be held at Onley Equestrian Centre, Rugby, Warwickshire on Saturday 25th & Sunday 26th September 2026. If a horse/pony has already qualified, cards may be handed down to 6th place at judge's discretion. Each qualified horse/pony will receive a qualification card in the ring which will enable the owner to enter the Championship Show, provided the owner and rider/handler are, or become registered with the Concours d'Elegance Society within 21 days of the qualifying show. Morning Classes

Ring 1: Indoor Arena

To be judged by: Lady R Holmes

To Start at 9.00am

The following classes are open to everyone, any horse or pony. You will jump your round and then do your individual directly after, you will be given a moment for your groom to remove your boots. Spurs are not permitted as per Working Hunter rules, except on working show horses. All classes are qualifiers for the Sunshine Tour, ESUK and Equifest

CLEAR ROUND 1- 30-40cm- *open to all, only 15 rounds available, please book early*

Class 1- Cradle Stakes- *Cross poles or bottom holes 30-35cm, 128cm & under, children not to exceed 12 years old. Lead reins welcome, lead reins must be attached to the noseband only*

Class 2- Nursery Stakes- *40-45cm 133cm & under, Children not to exceed 12 years old. Lead reins welcome, lead reins must be attached to the noseband only*

Mini Working Hunter Championship- 1st & 2nd from class 1-2

CLEAR ROUND 2- 50cm- *open to all, only 15 rounds available, please book early*

Class 3- Open 50cm Working Hunter- *open to any horse or pony, any rider. To include **Equifest Qualifier** for M&M and Open worker ponies.. The class will be judged as a whole but there will be two qualifying sections. Please inform the secretary's when collecting numbers of the section you wish to try to*

qualify for. You must have your Equifest competitor qualification sheet with you at the show for the qualification to be valid

Class 4- Open 60cm Working Hunter- *open to any horse or pony, any rider. To include **Equifest Qualifier** for M&M and Open worker ponies. The class will be judged as a whole but there will be two qualifying sections. Please inform the secretary's when collecting numbers of the section you wish to try to qualify for. You must have your Equifest competitor qualification sheet with you at the show for the qualification to be valid.*

Clear Round 3- 70cm- *open to all, only 15 rounds available, please book early*

Class 5- Open 70cm Working Hunter- *open to any horse or pony, any rider. To include **Equifest Qualifier** for M&M and Open worker ponies. The class will be judged as a whole but there will be two qualifying sections. Please inform the secretary's when collecting numbers of the section you wish to try to qualify for. You must have your Equifest competitor qualification sheet with you at the show for the qualification to be valid.*

Working Hunter Championship- 1st & 2nd from classes 3-5

Class 6- Open 80cm Working Hunter - *open to any horse or pony, any rider. To include **Equifest Qualifier** for M&M and Open workers. The class will be judged as a whole but there will be two qualifying sections. Please inform the secretary's when collecting numbers of the section you wish to try to qualify for. You must have your Equifest competitor qualification sheet with you at the show for the qualification to be valid.*

Class 7- Open 90cm Working Hunter- *open to any horse or pony, any rider. To include **Equifest Qualifier** for M&M and Open worker ponies. The class will be judged as a whole but there will be two qualifying sections. Please inform the secretary's when collecting numbers of the section you wish to try to qualify for. You must have your Equifest competitor qualification sheet with you at the show for the qualification to be valid.*

Class 8- Open 1m Working Hunter- *open to any horse or pony, rider any age. To include **Equifest Qualifier** Open Workers.. You must have your Equifest competitor qualification sheet with you at the show for the qualification to be valid.*

Working Hunter Championship- 1st & 2nd from classes 6-8

Class 9- Young Handler- *This class is open to any child 16 and under, all children must wear riding hats, any type of horse or pony may be shown*

Class 10- Adult Handler- *This class is open to anyone 16 to 45, any Horse or Pony may be shown*

Class 11- Senior Handler- *This class is open to anyone 45 years and over, any Horse or Pony may be shown*

Handler Championship- 1st & 2nd places from classes 9-11

Class 12- Miniature Horse and Shetland ponies- *Open to any Miniature Horse or Shetland* **Kindly Sponsored by Spellbound Miniatures**

Class 13- Small Breed Mountain and Moorland- *shetlands, exmoor, dartmoor, welsh A and welsh B. Open to any age.* **Equifest Qualifier**

Class 14- Large Breed Mountain and Moorland- *fell, dales, highland, Connemara, new forest, welsh C and welsh D. Open to any age.* **Equifest Qualifier**

Class 15- Show Ponies, Hunter Ponies and Part Breds- *open to any age. Ponies must be shown plaited, not to exceed 158cm* **Equifest Qualifier**

Class 16- Traditional Cobs And Native Types- *Open to any age, to be shown naturally.* **Kindly Sponsored by Kirsty Bolderston- Veterinary Physiotherapy**

Inhand Pony Championship- 1st & 2nd places from classes 12-16

Ring 3- Grass Ring

Class 17- Open Foal- *open to any 2026 foal. Foals may be on their dams sides*

Class 18- Open Yearling- *open to any yearling born in 2025*

Class 19- Open 2&3 Year olds- *open to any 2 & 3year olds, Colts should be bitted where appropriate*

Youngstock Championship- 1st & 2nd places from classes 17-19

Class 20- Show Horse- *open to any age, horses to be shown plaited or hogged for the appropriate class. Hacks, Riding Horses, Hunters, Show Cobs and Maxi Cobs*

Class 21- Warmbloods, Sports Horses, Irish Draughts, Thoroughbreds- *open to any age, horses to be shown plaited or Hogged. This class will be split if entries are high*

Class 22- Foreign Breed and Rare Breed- *open to any age, horses to be shown as per their breed standard. Breeds should be on the endangered breeds register ie Cleveland Bay, Suffolk Punch, Eskiray etc*

Class 23- Veteran Horse or Pony- *Horses/ponies to be shown plaited, hogged, trimmed or naturally. Must be 15 years of age or over. 1st and 2nd get direct qualification to the supreme* **Equifest Qualifier Kindly Sponsored by Spellbound Miniatures**

Inhand Horse Championship- 1st & 2nd places from classes 20-23

Class 24- Coloured Horse or Pony - *open to any age, to be shown plaited or hogged, or naturally* **Equifest Qualifier**

Class 25- Solid Colour Horse or Pony- *Open to any horse or pony with a solid coat, may have markings. Bays, Greys, Chestnut, Black.*

Class 26- Odd Colour Horse or Pony- *open to any horse or Pony with a palomino, buckskin, Dun, cremello, roans or spotted coat, May have markings.*

Class 28- Best Turned out- *open to any combination, inhand or ridden. Entrants will be purely judged on the turnout and its appropriateness to its type*

Class 29- My Best Friend- *open to any combination, tell the judge just why you love your horses/ponies and show them any tricks*

Class 30- Tiny Tots Young Handler- *open to young handlers under 7 years old. May be accompanied*

Class 31- Novice Handler- *open to handlers that have not won more than two handler classes in or before 2026*

Class 32- Novice Horse or Pony- *open to true novice ponies/horses that have not won more than two novice classes in or before 2026*

Class 33- Concours D'Elegance- *Open to any combination, ridden or inhand*

Ring 2- Grass Ring

Not to Start before 1.30pm

To Be Judged by: Mrs C Whiteley

Class 34- Lead Rein Pony- *Open to any pony not exceeding 128cm, leadreins should be attached to the noseband. Riders not to have exceeded the 9th Birthday. Ponies to be 4 years old and over* **Equifest Qualifier for those eligible**

Class 35- First Ridden Pony- *Open to any pony not exceeding 128cm. Riders not to have exceeded their 12th Birthday. Ponies to be 4 years old and over* **Equifest Qualifier for those eligible**

Class 36- Junior Ridden Pony- *Open to any pony, not exceeding 148cm. Riders to not have exceeded their 16th birthday. Ponies to be 4 years old and over* **Equifest Qualifier for those eligible**

Junior Rider Championship- 1st & 2nd placings from classes 34-36

Class 37- Ridden Mountain and Moorland- *Shetlands, Exmoor, Dartmoor, Welsh A,B,C,D, Fell, Dales, Highland, New Forest and Connemara. Lead reins permitted. Special rosettes to highest placed small and large breed. This class will be split if sufficient entries. Open to ponies 4 years old and over. Highest placed small or large breed to go forward for the pony championship if not placed 1st or second* **Equifest Qualifier**

Class 38- Ridden Show Ponies, Hunter Ponies and Part Breds- *open to any age. Ponies must be shown plaited, not to exceed 158cm. Lead reins permitted* **Equifest Qualifier for those eligible**

Class 39- Ridden Traditional Cob And Native Types- *open to horses 4 years and over, to be shown naturally.*

Class 40- Performance Pony- *this class has been added for those that are wanting a practice for upcoming LIHS qualifiers or those that may like to give it a go before entering a qualifier. This will be an open class. Riders 18 & under. Ponies not to exceed 158cm. You will need to read what is expected of your individual show as certain movements are expected in this class. As this is purely a practice class and NOT a qualifier, M&M's may be excused from being plaited especially if competing in other classes.* **Kindly Sponsored by Team Anvils**

Class 40A- Performance Horse or Pony- *this class has been added for those that are wanting a practice for upcoming LIHS qualifiers or those that may like to give it a go before entering a qualifier. This will be an open class. Riders 18 & Over. You will need to read what is expected of your individual show as certain movements are expected in this class. As this is purely a practice class and NOT a qualifier, M&M's may be excused from being plaited especially if competing in other classes.* **Kindly Sponsored by Team Anvils**

Ridden Pony Championship- 1st & 2nd placings from classes 37-40a- Kindly Sponsored by ALS Equestrian

Ring 3- Grass Ring

Not to Start before 1.30pm

To Be Judged by: Mr H Peck

Class 41- Novice Walk and Trot- *open to true novices, 4 years and over and not to have won more than 2 firsts this season. Please use this class as intended. Open to any rider. Lead reins allowed*

Class 42- Open Novice- *open to any horse or pony, 4 years and over. Not to have won ore than 3 firsts this season. Must show a canter in their individual show, may be asked to canter in the go round. Open to any Rider*

Class 43- First Year Combination- *open to any horse or pony, 4 years and over. Open to combinations in their first showing year together.*

Novice Championship- 1st & 2nd from classes 41-43

Class 44- Ridden Show Horse- *open to horses 4 years old and over, horses to be shown plaited or hogged for the appropriate class. Hacks, Riding Horses, Hunters, Show Cobs and Maxi Cobs **Equifest Qualifier.***

Highest placed Hack, Riding Horse, Hunter, Cob and Maxi Cob will earn their individual ticket

Class 45- Ridden Thoroughbreds, Irish Draughts, Sports Horses and Warmbloods- *open to horses 4 years old and over, horses do not have to have raced, to be shown plaited*

Class 46- Ridden Foreign and Rare Breed- *open to any age, horses to be shown as per their breed standard. Rare Breeds should be on the endangered breeds register ie Cleveland Bay, Suffolk Punch, Eskiray etc*

Class 47- Ridden Veteran Horse or Pony- *Horses/ponies to be shown plaited, hogged, trimmed or naturally. Must be 15 years of age or over. 1st and 2nd get direct qualification to the supreme **Equifest Qualifier- Kindly Sponsored by Kirsty Bolderston- Veterinary Physiotherapy***

Ridden Championship- 1st & 2nd placings from classes 44-47

Class 48- Ridden Coloured Horse or Pony- *open to horses, with a broken colour coat, 4 years old an over, to be shown plaited, hogged or naturally. **Equifest Qualifier***

Class 49- Ridden Solid Colour Horse or Pony - *open to horses, horses to be bay, black, chestnut, grey, dun, buckskin, palomino etc, face and leg markings are permitted, 4 years old an over, to be shown plaited, hogged or naturally*

Ridden Colour Championship- 1st & 2nd placings from classes 48-49- Kindly Sponsored by the Mace Family

Ring 4- Grass Ring

Not to start before 2.15pm

To be Judged by: Mrs E Lewis

Class 50- Tiny Tots Walk and Trot- *Open to children under 6 years old. Open to any suitable pony.*

Snaffle bridles only.

Class 51- Novice First Ridden- *open to children just stepping out to first ridden, must be in their first year. Parental support may be given in the ring. Open to any suitable pony*

Class 52- Novice Rider- *This class is strictly for novice riders. Not to have won more than 2 classes, riders can be any age. Canter is optional. Snaffle bridles only*

Class 53- Adult Rider- *open to any horse or pony, 4 years and over. Riders 18-44*

Class 54- Senior Rider- *Open to any horse or pony, 4years and over. Riders to exceed 45 years old*

Ridden Open Championship- 1st and 2nd places from classes 50-54
